

## Action Taken Based on Curriculum Feedback Report

Feedback system based on curriculum is effectively implemented and analysed for imparting better academic credentials to the students. As part of this, feedback is collected from different stake holders viz. students, teachers, parents and alumni about the various aspects on curriculum/syllabus and its effective updating, suiting the need for its revival and on infrastructure and other facilities such as laboratory and other amenities related teaching and learning process. Report received from various departments was collected and its analysis was done with the help of committee constituted for the purpose. Feedback collected from the students are collected, consolidated by the committee meant for it and is handed over to respective departments. Based on the report received various department level meetings were convened and relevant measures are implemented. Most of the grievances were elated to lack of time for studying due hectic exam schedules. Student's response to the Teaching Learning experience seems encouraging with 92% effective communication between teacher and students, 80% use of ICT tools and 95% of teacher's punctuality and regularity. There were also certain things that were of concern, which needs talks at higher levels to address the cases viz. related to better infrastructure, lack of placements etc. It has been communicated to faculties through Heads of various department that the department members complete 100% of syllabus within each semester everyone without any exception. No lapses or counter argument can be entertained in this regard. As for internal assessment, continuous assessment based on tests and assignments rather than a single test / assignment at the end to be done; and it has been reiterated that all

tests/assignments be promptly, objectively and carefully evaluated.

In the context of the reviewing and restructuring of the syllabus and curriculum, thefaculty members of our college who are members of various Board of studies take up the views as reflected in the feedback and suitable changes are incorporated as per the present system demands. Constructive recommendations are put into practice during the coming academic year. Since one of our faculty members was represented in the senate of theUniversity more active measures can be taken to annul certain issues related time schedule of semester end exam and study leave. Same way the report received from different stake holders such as teachers, parents and alumni were also gone through deliberations and possible points that can be included to improve the academic activities was implemented. Through this way curriculum revision and implementation was practised in the college.
